AUTHORIZATION FOR DISPENSING MEDICATIONS

Whenever possible, medications should be given at home. Every effort should be made to avoid dispensing medication during school hours. State law mandates the following information be given to the school <u>before any medication or treatment can be administered or provided.</u>

- 1. Written permission from the parent or guardian.
- 2. Written prescription from the doctor, including time of administration. This includes over the counter medication, such as Tylenol.
- 3. Parent or any adult must bring the medication to school. No child is allowed to bring medication to school.
- 4. Medication must be in a pharmacy labeled container. It cannot be given if it is not in a properly labeled bottle.
