- Headphones for their Chromebook or iPad
- Beach towel for quiet time
- Sneakers (Children need to wear sneakers for gym class and it's preferred that they wear them on the playground as well for safety reasons.) Please no flip flops or any shoe without a back such as a sandal or crocs without a back strap. We will be traveling up and down stairs daily and we want them to be safe. Sandals or crocs with the strap in the back are fine, but then please send in sneakers on gym (PE) days. I will be sending home our schedule once our school year begins. We have PE every other day.

The following items are not mandatory, but if you'd like to donate them at some point in the school year I'd appreciate it. I will be donating to the classroom as well:

- Tissues
- Paper Towels
- Lysol or Clorox Wipes
