"BE IT RESOLVED THAT, Nicole Petranchuk, Douglas Mohorter, Mary Schiltz, Linda Law, Ronald Perry, Daphne Valentine, Cheryl West, Valerie DiFlorio, Paula Kopp is hereby certified as Qualified Lead Evaluator of classroom teachers having successfully completed the following training requirements prescribed in 8 NYCRR §30-2.9 (b):

- (1) The New York State Teaching Standards, their related elements and performanceIndicators and the Leadership Standards, and their related functions, as applicable;
- (2) Evidence-based observation techniques that are grounded in research;
- (3) Application and use of the student growth percentile model and the value-added growth model as defined in 8 NYCRR §30-2.2;
- (4) Application and use of the State-approved teacher rubrics selected by the <u>East Syracuse Minoa CSD</u> for use in the evaluation of **classroom teachers**, including training on the effective application of such rubric to observe a **classroom teacher's** practice;
- (5) Application and use of the assessment tools that the <u>East Syracuse Minoa CSD</u> utilizes to evaluate its **classroom teachers**, including, but not limited to <u>multiple classroom observations and</u> structured reviews of lesson plans and/or student work;
- (6) Application and use of the State-approved locally selected measures of student achievement used by the <u>East Syracuse Minoa CSD</u> to evaluate its **classroom teachers**;
- (7) The scoring methodology utilized by the Department and the <u>East Syracuse Minoa CSD</u> to evaluate a **classroom teacher** under 8 NYCRR §30-2, including:
  - (a) how scores are generated for each subcomponent and the composite effectiveness score of **classroom teachers**, and
  - (b) application and use of the scoring ranges prescribed by the Commissioner for the four designated rating categories used for the overall rating of **classroom teachers** and their subcomponent ratings; and
- (8) Specific considerations in evaluating **classroom teachers** of English language learners and students with disabilities."

"Training on the use of the Statewide Instructional Reporting System, also required by 8 NYCRR §30-2.9 (b), will be provided once the NYS Education Department makes available the information required for such training."

### E. Building Our Spartan Future II - Capital Project Proposition

"WHEREAS, the East Syracuse Minoa Central School District is a local agency pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), ECL Section 8-0101, et seq., and implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617 (the "Regulations"); and

WHEREAS, the District is considering undertaking a District wide project consisting of the construction and reconstruction of improvements to mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systemS at the Central High School, Pine Grove Middle School, East Syracuse Elementary School, Fremont Elementary School, Minoa Elementary School, Woodland Elementary School and Park Hill School; exterior and interior building improvements, chiller plant replacement, and site improvements, including, but not limited to parking lot reconstruction with drainage improvements at the Central High School; and the reconstruction of tennis courts at Pine Grove Middle School, all including site work, original furnishings, fixtures and equipment, architectural fees, and all other costs incidental to such work (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the District's Board has reviewed the scope of the Project with its architects and received and considered the advice of its architects with respect to the potential for environmental impacts resulting from the proposed action; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the Project with respect to the criteria set forth in 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c) and determined by resolution adopted September 15, 2025 that the Project is a Type II Action under SEQRA which requires no further SEQRA review."

"NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Board of Education as follows:

- Section 1. A Special Meeting of the qualified voters of the District will be held in the East Syracuse Minoa Central School District Central High School small gym, 6400 Fremont Road, East Syracuse, New York 13057 on December 17, 2025 from 12:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. prevailing time, for the purpose of voting on the proposition described in the Notice of Special. District Meeting hereinafter set forth.
- Section 2. The business to be acted upon at said Special District Meeting shall be as stated in the Notice thereof, and the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Notice of said Special District Meeting to be published in the Post Standard, a newspaper having a general circulation within the District, such publications to be made four (4) times each in such newspaper within the seven (7) weeks next preceding such Special District Meeting, the first publication to be at least forty-five (45) days prior to the date of said Special District Meeting.
- Section 3. Said Special District Meeting shall be called by giving the following notice thereof: "THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE EAST SYRACUSE MINOA CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that pursuant to a Resolution adopted by the Board of Education of the District on October 9, 2025, a special meeting of the qualified voters of said East Syracuse Minoa Central School District in the Counties of Onondaga and Madison, State of New York, will be held in the Central High School small gym, 6400 Fremont Road, East Syracuse, New York 13057 on December 17, 2025 from 12:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. prevailing time, for the purpose of voting upon the following proposition:

### **PROPOSITION**

"Shall the Board of Education undertake a District wide project consisting of the construction and reconstruction of improvements to mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems at the Central High School, Pine Grove Middle School, East Syracuse Elementary School, Fremont Elementary School, Minoa Elementary School, Woodland Elementary School and Park Hill School; exterior and interior building improvements, chiller plant replacement, and site improvements including parking lot reconstruction with drainage improvements at the Central High School; and the reconstruction of tennis courts at Pine Grove Middle School, all including site work, original furnishings, fixtures and equipment, architectural fees, and all other costs incidental to such work (the "Project") at a total estimated cost not to exceed \$49,650,000 and obtain the necessary funds by using up to \$3,121,690 from the 2017 Capital Reserve Fund, and \$9,309,290 from the 2024 Capital Reserve Fund and, for the balance, the levy of a tax in the amount of \$37,219,020 upon the taxable property of the District to be collected in annual installments in the years and in the amounts as the Board of Education shall determine and in anticipation of such tax bonds and notes of the District are hereby authorized to be issued at one time, or from time to time, in the principal amount not to exceed \$37,219,020, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said obligations when due."

"NOTICE IS GIVEN that voting upon the foregoing Proposition will be by paper ballot or voting machine and will take place in the Central High School small gym, 6400 Fremont Road, East Syracuse, New York 13057 on December 17, 2025 from 12:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. prevailing time."

"NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that qualified voters may obtain applications for an absentee ballot or early voting ballot from the office of the Clerk of the District. Completed applications for an absentee ballot or early voting ballot must be received by the District Clerk of the District no later than 4:00 P.M. prevailing time, on December 16, 2025 and must be received no later than 4:00 P.M. prevailing time, on December 10, 2025 if the absentee ballot or early voting ballot to be mailed to the voter. Completed applications received after 4:00 P.M. on December 10, 2025, will require the voter to personally appear at the Office of the Clerk of the District to receive an absentee ballot or early voting ballot. A listing of all persons to whom an absentee ballot or early voting ballot is issued will be available for inspection by any qualified voter in the Office of the Clerk of the District between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. during each of the five (5) business days prior to the election."

"NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that military ballots may be applied for by qualified voters by requesting an application from the District Clerk at (315) 434-3004 or <a href="kskahen@esmschools.org">kskahen@esmschools.org</a>. Completed applications for military ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 4:00 P.M. on November 20, 2025. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the application or ballot by mail, facsimile transmission or electronic mail."

- Section 4. The vote upon the proposition to be submitted to qualified voters shall be by ballot on voting machines and the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to have the necessary ballot labels printed in form corresponding as nearly as may be with the requirements of the Education Law.
- Section 5. The Clerk of the District is hereby authorized and directed in the name of and on behalf of the District to do all acts and things necessary, following the advice and counsel of the District's Attorney and the District's Bond Counsel, to comply with all applicable laws, regulations and executive orders relating to the Special Meeting to be held on December 17, 2025, and to do all other acts as may be necessary, or in the opinion of the District's Attorney and the District's Bond Counsel, desirable or proper to effectuate the purposes of the foregoing Resolution and to cause compliance by the District with all applicable laws, regulations and executive orders relating to the notice of, and procedural steps to be taken in connection with such Special Meeting.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately."
