WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of the proposed lease agreement between the District and OCM BOCES are deemed to be fair and reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the East Syracuse Minoa School District hereby approves the lease of Pine Grove Middle School, to OCM BOCES for the purpose of operating its Extended School Year Special Education Summer School program; and
