Our Three Year Old Goals For Your Child

Social-Emotional Goals:

This year our main goal is to socialize your child with other children and to teach them how to be a student in a classroom with many other children.

We would like your child to be able to:

- Use self-help skills
- Use words to express needs and wants
- Appropriately solve conflicts with peers
- Demonstrate body and space awareness
- Take turns with others
- Separate from family confidently

Math Readiness:

During the course of our year, it is our goal for students to be able to:

- Identify nine basic colors
- Count verbally from 1-10
- Identify number 1-5
- Identify four basic shapes

Pre-K Readiness:

In preparation for our four year old Pre-k program next year, we are modelling student behavior daily for your child. We are hoping that your child will be able to:

- Listen attentively
- Follow verbal directions
- Handle materials carefully
- Has good clean up habits
- Participate in group activities
- Follow the classroom routine

Motor Skills:

Students will begin to use new materials in our classroom. They will be challenged to play and move their bodies in new ways. We would like your child to be able to:

- Fit small items together
- Hold a writing utensil correctly
- Snip with scissors
- Climb stairs with alternating feet
- Move with purpose from place to place using body control

Language and Reading Readiness:

Your child will be exposed to different forms of literature daily. The staff in the class will encourage your child to:

- Show interest in books & stories
- Hold books and turn pages appropriately
- Recognize their own name in print
- States first letter of their own name
- Sing and follow hand movements of familiar songs and rhymes

During the year you will receive two progress reports. One will be in January and the other in June. The report will provide you details about where your child is in the mastery of these skills and goals!
