

### **CHS/Transportation** *Capital Improvement Project*

On January 12, residents will be asked to consider a \$19.1 million building improvement plan, with a focus on Building Our Spartan Future as the next chapter in the District's long and short range plan for the responsible care of its facilities.

The ESM community has supported a number of projects for the improvement and maintenance of our facilities. As a result, our District is proud to offer state-of-the-art teaching and learning environments. We have also completed critical upgrades for security, safety, and infrastructure.

For this project, ESM Central High School would undergo improvements to highly visible, highly used areas, offering significant benefits to students, staff and the ESM community. The district is also proposing key Transportation Center improvements that will address several important infrastructure needs.

The District receives a significant amount of state building aid for capital projects and this, combined with reserve funds and declining debt from previous capital projects, means that the \$19.1 million price tag for the project is not anticipated to increase school taxes.
